Slide the Transposing Slider from the old key, C, to the new key D#/E \flat . C becomes D#/E \flat , C#/D \flat becomes E, D becomes F, and so on.

Slide the I/tonic under the new key (D#/E \flat). Use the dots to identify the notes in the major, minor, dominant, diminished, and augmented chords.

MasterKey's flip side can transpose, too!

- Ionian mode
- Dorian mode
- Phrygian mode
- Lydian mode
- Mixolydian mode
